THE MLK: Founded in 1922 and renamed after Dr. King in 1968, the Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Community Center (MLK) is a multi-service provider for at-risk and underserved individuals, families and children in support of its mission to nourish, educate, and support Newport County, Rhode Island residents to improve their economic, social, and physical wellbeing. An independent non-profit, the Center served 5,670 individuals last year, the most in its history.

THE PROGRAM: Piloted in 2018, the Mobile Food Pantry (MFP) makes regular visits to low income neighborhoods in Newport, Middletown, Portsmouth, Jamestown, and Tiverton. The refrigerated truck brings the MLK's pantry to those who cannot visit the Center, often due to lack of transportation. Healthy food is offered, including fresh milk, eggs and produce, bread, frozen meat and household and personal care items. Clients choose foods that meet their personal, dietary, and cultural preferences. The program operates year-round.

THE IMPACT:

 \gt 2018: **9 visits** \rightarrow \rightarrow \rightarrow 2019: **37 visits** \rightarrow \rightarrow \rightarrow 2022: **156 visits** (The Center and the MFP have remained in constant operation throughout the COVID-19 pandemic.)
