Position Summary

Counselors will work with elementary school youth, rising first to fifth graders who will be engaged through experiential learning throughout the summer. Summer Camp runs from July 3rd - August 25th and the ideal candidate should be available all 8 weeks of camp focused on summer learning loss prevention. Part of your duties would include transporting campers to **field trips** in the Center's small van.

Qualifications

- High school diploma or equivalent
- Experience working in a summer camp setting preferred.
- Ability to work with children and keep them actively engaged in a variety of activities.
- 21+ who is willing to obtain their chauffeur's license in order to transport campers in the Center's van.
- Must complete Background Check, CANTS, and be willing to complete all immunization requirements that are mandated by the State of Rhode Island
- Strong interpersonal skills and ability to communicate with all levels including staff, parents, and children.
- Be available for all weeks of the summer camp program.
