Every parent that comes to Santa's Workshop for help is unique. This is Jake's story.

Jake came to us late this week, on the last day of our program. He works full time for a medical transport company but he's homeless. He and his wife and young daughter and infant son are living in a hotel. *"Every dollar goes first to a place to live, and then to baby formula. I couldn't even think about Christmas until now, and I didn't know what to do. My kids are my whole heart."*

After Jake chose toys for his children, he talked about how tough it's been. His monthly income is \$200 too high to qualify for SNAP food assistance. We told him he could get help from the food pantry, and from other programs like lunches and dinners and fresh veggie distribution.

Jake left the MLK with holiday gifts and bags of food for his family. He turned around as he left the door. His eyes were damp as he said,

"Thank you. You made our Christmas."
