SUMMARY:

This position is responsible for maintaining a sanitary and safe environment for food handling, storage and service in compliance with state regulations.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Assist with food preparation.
- Maintain an orderly and clean prep area applying safe food handling practices.
- Assist in serving meals.
- Clean up after meal preparation, including all pots, pans, and serving dishes.
- Help unload and store supplies.
- Assist in any area of kitchen or dining room as requested by the Kitchen Manager.
- Clean dishwasher area after every meal, maintain a clean dishwashing area during meal, wipe off dishwasher and keep surrounding area dry and clean.
- Wash and put away all dishes, silverware and glasses.
- Performs other related duties as assigned
- Maintain positive and friendly customer services for volunteers, clients, and staff members
