


#### Lunch & Learn: Carousing Sailors to Boutique Tourists: The Transformation of Newport's Wharves, 1950 - 2000

We are so grateful to our generous funders and our community partners who help us give our kids such amazing summer experiences. It truly takes a village! Stay tuned for more updates!


