## **Celebrating Hunger Action Month**

September is <u>Hunger Action Month</u> and we're spreading awareness and highlighting our hunger services.

We have 11 programs at the Center dedicated to hunger relief. Let's break it down:

- 1,392,332 meals distributed 20% more than last year
- 38,065 hot breakfasts provided
- 1,396 deliveries to homebound seniors 7% more than last year
- 180 Mobile Food Pantry visits to 17 neighborhoods in Newport County.
- 85,570 meals distributed from our Middletown High School and Tiverton High School Food Pantries
- 2,320 people from 901 families received Thanksgiving meals

We are so excited to make more great memories with our students this school year!








# Our Furry Friends are Part of the Community Too!
