

### **The Situation Table**

Each week, I join 15 other agencies including Newport and Middletown public safety teams, Newport Mental Health, Newport Hospital, and more for **The Situation Table**. We work collaboratively on two common goals:

- 1. To reduce the elevated risk amongst vulnerable residents in our community
- 2. Collect data to understand our community and report to a national risk-tracking database for community safety.

The Situation Table model was originated in Canada (<u>click here to learn more</u>) and **it considers 105 risk factors** such as crime victimization, criminal involvement, self-harm, physical health, mental health, housing, basic needs, and more. Based on these risk factors, we discuss care and resources needed to help individuals on a situation-by-situation basis.

We are proud to join community leaders to have these important conversations to help Newport County's **most at risk citizens**.


